All chapters will undergo peer review prior to publication. Submissions must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Authors are requested to follow the MLA style (9th Edition) strictly while preparing the chapters. Authors are also requested to include the following in the format of their chapters:

- ✓ Full title with subtitle, if any. Times New Roman font, size 14, bold (not all capital letters).
- ✓ Name, designation and affiliation of the author/s.
- ✓ An abstract of the chapter of about 200–250 words and Keywords.
- ✓ Authors should note that the main body of the text should be prepared in such a way that not much formatting is needed afterwards. Use Times New

Roman font, size 12 and keep it justified. All paragraphs should be indented.

- ✓ The chapters should be around 2500–3000 words inclusive of Works Cited in MS Word document.
- ✓ The author should be very careful regarding grammatical and typographical errors.
- ✓ All chapters submitted for review must be in English.
- ✓ Plagiarism and AI content should be avoided. (please check from some reliable software).
- ✓ A self-declaration (for the chapter not submitted anywhere else and its originality) and author's bio-note should be sent along with the book chapter.

PUBLICATION AND PROCESSING FEE

- There will be **NO** Publication and Processing fee for chapter authors.
- Each contributor can purchase his/her copy of the published book at a very nominal cost of Rs. 600/- approx.
- The book will be published with ISBN
